## Modern Slavery Act Statement FY 2023/24.

The Company Directors and Senior Management shall take the responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources (training etc.) and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organisation or within its supply chains. This statement is made pursuant to Section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes the company's slavery and human trafficking statement for the current financial year, the policy statement will be reviewed annually and published accordingly.
